This Indenture, made the third day
of April in the year of our Lord one
thousand eight hundred and eighty eight
between John F. Hest of the City of Easton

and Robert J. Hest of the City and County of Philadelphia
State aforesaid and Harlem P. Hest of the City of Easton a-
foresaid parties of the second part, Witnesseth, That the
said parties of the first part, for and in consideration of the
sum of Five thousand seven hundred Dollars lawful
money of the United States of America, unto them well and
truly paid by the said parties of the second part, at or be-
fore the sealing and delivery of these presents, the receipt
whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained,
sold, aliened, conveyed, released, conveyed and confirmed and
by these presents do grant, bargain, sell, alien, convey, release
convey and confirm unto the said parties of the second part
their heirs and assigns forever, the full and undivided
one third interest in and to, All that Certain, Factory
Slate, quarry, and tract of land situate in the Borough
of Slatington in the County of Lehigh and State aforesaid
Bounded and described as follows to wit, Beginning at a
Black Oak tree and corner of Benjamin Hest's land, thence
by land of Dr. D. Jones, North eighty seven degrees and a
half East eleven and three tenths perches to a corner, thence still
by the same, South ten degrees East eleven and three
tenths perches to a stone, thence by land of Robert McDowell
North eighty seven and a half degrees East, twenty eight and
eight tenths perches to a stone, thence by land of Henry
A. unity North eleven and a half degrees West eleven and
three tenths perches to a post, thence North eighty seven
